Spring-Time Greetings to Everyone:

As winter falls behind us and spring welcomes us in her grasp, the days become warmer and the daylight longer. This is the time of year for sprucing up around the house and maybe tackling some of those jobs left over from last year. This is also the time when our children are outside more often playing and enjoying the weather.

As spring approached this year, we saw an increase in the number of youngsters operating motorized vehicles, go-karts, mini scooters, just to name a few, on our roadways. This has raised some safety concerns since these vehicles are usually lower to the ground, harder to see and difficult to judge their direction. According to Florida Stat. 316.2123, an ATV, ROV, and OHM cannot be operated on a public road. Go-karts fall under the ROV listing.

Another area of concern are the golf carts driven throughout the Park. To safely and legally operate a golf cart, under the Florida Stat. 316.212, drivers must be at least fourteen years of age and the area designated as an approved golf cart location. This also applies to the motorized equipment being operated on our green space and in our preservation areas, which is prohibited in our CC&R's.

All of these regulations serve a purpose to keep our children and community a safe place to live, as well as to maintain the beauty of our park! So please, let's have a safe and enjoyable summer.

- Store trash carts in the garage or if stored outside they should be kept behind a fence, shrubs or in area not visible from the street or adjacent lot.
